3 TYPES OF DOOR SWEEPS

Interior doors normally don't have bottom sweeps
The sweep on the interior cellar door is a 1 3/4 brown universal sweep cut down to 1 3/8



The **interior** sweeps are stapled to the bottom of the door.

The **exterior** fiberglass door sweeps are $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " brown universal sweeps that snap up into 2 grooves spaced at $\frac{7}{8}$ " apart in the bottom of the exterior front door. Has 4 fins 9/16 long and an angled fin on each edges. They do not slide in from the end. **New supplier is** _"Allaboutdoors.com" description is 2 Barbs @7/8" Door Bottom / sweep 2 colors (no part number)



The bulkhead interior door is steel with 2 grooves in the bottom spaced at 1 $^3/_8$ " apart . The groove spacing is different from the fiberglass front door.
