

## 3 TYPES OF DOOR SWEEPS

**Interior** doors normally don't have bottom sweeps

The sweep on the interior cellar door is a 1 3/4" brown universal sweep cut down to 1 3/8"



The **interior** sweeps are stapled to the bottom of the door.

The **exterior** fiberglass door sweeps are 1 3/4" brown universal sweeps that snap up into 2 grooves spaced at 7/8" apart in the bottom of the exterior front door. Has 4 fins 9/16" long and an angled fin on each edge. They do not slide in from the end. **New supplier is** "Allaboutdoors.com" description is 2 Barbs @7/8" Door Bottom / sweep 2 colors (no part number)



The bulkhead interior door is steel with 2 grooves in the bottom spaced at  $1\frac{3}{8}$ " apart . The groove spacing is different from the fiberglass front door.
